
Dear Parents/Carers.

Derek has started sessions on a Monday at 9.30am and 12.30pm with lots of children signed up and enjoying learning new skills.



Armadale Nursery Class Session Times


Can we remind parents and carers of our nursery session times..


Please ensure children are collected on time to allow staff to set up for the next session.
