Families Connect

Mrs Brown (Early Years Officer) and Sharlene (Family Support Worker) will be offering a Families Connect programme this term.

Sessions will run for 2 hours, once a week for 8 weeks.

This programme will give you new ideas to support your children's learning in

- Literacy and language development
- Numeracy
- Emotional development

Each activity encourages parents and children to spend quality time together by talking about specific topics and reflecting on what you already do to support your child's learning.

The programme is designed for children aged 4 to 6 years of age and is particularly useful for children moving into Primary 1 after the summer.

If your child is moving on to school after the summer and you are interested to find out more, please attend our informal coffee morning on Thursday 25^{th} April at 9am in the Family Learning Zone, or speak to Mrs Brown in the nursery.
